## Fifth Grade Supply List for 2023-2024

I strive to have an organized classroom with a minimum of visual distractions, as I believe students work best when they have open space in front of them. The students have a place for all of their school belongings-but no space for toys, boxes of crayons/markers, or large quantities of school supplies.

I have tables in my room, not desks. Students each have a small bin on the table for a few pencils, an eraser, a single pack of post-it notes, and a highlighter. Please do NOT send in pencil boxes/cases.

I have colored pencils available for the class, so students do not need any art supplies for my class. They will receive a separate list of the supplies they need for art class from Mrs. Conquest. These must be able to fit into a shoebox-sized bin (sketchbooks will be stored separately).

\*I highly recommend wisdomsupplyco.com for school supplies. Their prices are higher, but everything they sell is environmentally conscious and plastic free. I am a big fan of their pencils, natural rubber erasers, and metal pencil sharpeners. Their metal pencil cases are small enough to fit into the tabletop bins, and therefore Ms. Sutherland–approved.

1. Four composition notebooks with cardboard (not plastic) covers--no binders or spiral notebooks

\*2. One package of 12 #2 pencils (no mechanical pencils) Please consider ordering from wisdomsupplyco.com!

\*3. Erasers

4. A ruler

5. Two packages of 3x5 index cards (one ruled and one unruled)

6. One roll of paper towels (recycled would be great!)

7. One box of kleenex

8. One (only one, please) package of 1-1/2 x 2" post-it notes

\*9. Two highlighters (please do not send in more than two) The wax peel markers work really well–and no plastic!

10. One bottle of hand sanitizer
